Environment	Surroundings or conditions we live in.
Society	People living together in a community.
Economy	The way in which a country produces and uses goods and money
Sustainable development	All systems – the economy, society and environment – coming together in harmony to preserve the planet.
Carbon footprint	The amount of carbon dioxide released into the atmosphere as a result of the activities of an individual, organisation or community.
Eco-efficiency	Linking environmental and economic efficiency.
Climate change	The signals coming from the earth that it is heating up.
Ecological rucksack	The invisible 'baggage' carried by most products in the form of energy, materials and negative environmental effects that went into their manufacture and transport.
Carbon neutral	To do things such as planting trees to reduce carbon dioxide by the same amount as is produced.
Carbon off-sets	Off-setting your carbon emissions could involve investing in a forest conservation project to reduce the effect of your activities on climate change.
Greenhouse gas	A gas that causes the greenhouse effect. CO <sub>2</sub> (Carbon Dioxide) is the most well known. This can cause a rise in average temperatures.
Logistics	This is the process of ensuring the right supplies and products are in the right place at the right time, at a competitive cost.
Production	The manufacturing process within a business
Supply chain	The processes involved in the production and distribution of a product.
Haulage	Transport of goods.
Freight	Transport of goods in containers or by water or by air.
Shipment	The shipping of goods.
PESTLE	Political, Economic, Social, Technological Legal and Environmental
Fishery	Area of sea where fishing is carried out.
